- Aaron also shared the latest ticket data and conveyed that ticket data has been gathered for the past 3 years(thanks to Joy), student bike accident data is being compiled by Hartshorn Health Center
- 11:35 Jamie Gaskill-Fox (FCBikes and Bike FC) outlined plans for

- Development of Mandatory Bicycle Education program for fleet vehicles in Fort Collins
 - A further step would be the addition of a Bike Friendly driver program/Stickers

11:40 Walking tour of bike facilities on campus with stops at:

- Corner of University Avenue and the Mountain Loop to discuss the striping on University Avenue (between the walking mall and Meridian) that will take place this weekend. Bike lanes will be down the middle with 3 cross walks and two roundabouts
- The bike counter in front of Braden Hall. CSU has 4 of the 24 bike counters in the state. Aaron will begin sharing that data at our CBAC meetings
- Corner of Mountain Loop and Pitkin discussing possible strategies for opening crossing at the Newton statue for bikes and how that stretch of Pitkin can satisfy local bike/ped needs as well working with the City low stress bike network
- Corner of Lake and Center to observe the challenges at that intersection and discuss the Prospect and Center underpass adjacent to Aggie Village North
- Pitkin (across from Chemistry/Biology construction and adjacent to Animal Science) discussing the role both East Pitkin and the SE corner of the Prairie Loop (Monfort Quad down to Lake St) will play in streamlining bicycling in that area of campus
- Last stop was on East Drive to observe the new contra-flow lane striping which allows bike sharrows use southbound and bike lane use northbound. Final marking to be completed very soon (maybe today)
