Admissions Bike Tours (Aaron)-

- A platinum achievement!
- Admissions agreed to do campus tours starting in June on Tuesdays, Wednesdays and Thursdays at 9am for a 1.5-hour ride
 - 3-4 Staff members from Admissions are taking the TS101 class
- These tours will be offered throughout the summer
- Recycled Cycles will be providing bicycles
- There will be a new tour route around construction
- Participants have to sign waiver and wear a helmet
- We are one of only a few universities doing this!
- Admissions wants to put in a bike share station in front of their building eventually
- Route: Admissions bldg. → Recycled Cycles in the LSC → Rec Center → Moby → The Spoke → Plum St → The Great Green → South to Braiden Hall → Pitkin St → The University Max station → Old Main/ Oval → Dismount zone walk

Covered Bike Parking (David and Aaron)-

- David gets continual requests for covered parking, especially from Housing and Dining Services
- Construction projects usually include covered parking in the initial plans but usually drop these designs in the finishing process due to lack of funds
- Design standards need to be established and options need to be evaluated
 - CBAC has been tasked with coming up with recommended standards (September Goal)
 - Look at options and prices through a vendor vetting process
 - Present to CBAC on retrofitting styles, stand-alone styles, connected to building styles
 - Solar panels on the roof? Vertical bike racks on sides of buildings?
 - Building “in-house” is too expensive
 - Factors to take into account: Snowfall, snow plowing, wind, advertising (?), mag chloride hold up, modularity, recommend a base model with add ons, LEED language,
 - Look for funding sources
 - The project itself, Students, various departments
 - Donors and grants don’t seem to be as plausible
- A covered bike structure has been decided for the Max University station- Dero cage

Construction Update (David)-

- Summer construction projects:
 - Parking Garage- Open Fall of 2016
 - South lot being resurfaced so the tunnel will be closed for a short time in June
 - Pitkin waterline project- work will be done throughout the summer
 - With its completion, new stripping will be done to enhance bike infrastructure
 - Oval waterline project- A short closure will take place with phased series of work to be done
 - East Dr. from University Ave. to Pitkin St. will be closed all summer starting May 16th
 - During this time, the contraflow lane will be restriped
- Pitkin and Shields crossing
 - A separate bike lane will come from Springfield with a little median to pull up to (safe haven) to push a button to activate a hawk system to safely cross Shields to Pitkin
 - After crossing Shields, the bike lane will turn into a contraflow lane on the south side of Pitkin
 - The City of Fort Collins has a nice rendering of this area on their website
 - The hawk system does not allow for consistent crossing ability, cars get a chance
 - The Rockwell Hall crossing on Laurel will be updated with the hawk system as well
- Prospect Underpass Project
 - Two bike counters will be added to track north-south movements
- Witcomb sanitary line for stadium will be done in July
 - With this project on street parking will be going away and a bike path will be added
- The shared path south of Moby is currently being looked at and is in the bidding process (10-month project projection)

ASU Bike Tour (Aaron shared pictures from his visit)-

- Bread crumb style thermoplastic signs on the ground to guide people through the walk zone
- Parking garage- an indoor cage with two level racks that hold 30-40 bikes
- Bike shelter at downtown campus
- Very attractive eye-catching pedestrian wayfinding
- Beautiful transit terminal with flowering vine
- Good use of transitioning infrastructure with multipurpose roads and roundabouts
 - No sidewalks, truncated domes, grades changes are very intentional
- Portable wayfinding- good for game day
- Golf carts are used for all fleet vehicles
- Bike lockers in a caged area
- Road closure signs placed everywhere daily (sandwich boards)
- Student run valet parking throughout the campus
- Vertical bike parking due to more constricted footprint
