

## Campus Bicycle Advisory Committee Notes 7/14/16

### Agenda: West Elizabeth Enhanced Travel Corridor Plan

presentation from Amy Lewin with FC Moves and Emma Belmont with Transfort

- This corridor emphasizes high frequency transit, bicycling and walking
  - There are over 2000 cyclists a day in this corridor
- The scope is Elizabeth St from Overland Trail to Shields St
- This plan will go to City Council on August 16, 2016
- The goal of this corridor is to be adaptive and unique, address safety support interconnectivity of all modes
  - Stay within existing public right-of-way
  - Incorporate phasing of different improvements
    - 2016- small tweaks with bus routing and employing a crossing guard
    - Interim- complete the bike lanes
    - Final- buffered and protect lanes will be installed
- There is a 10-20-year time frame of completion on this project depending on money/grants (Max was a 20-year process from planning to completion)

- Amy and Emma have requested support from the CBAC for this plan.
  - A letter has been requested to help obtain a CDOT grant to fund the protected intersection at City Park and Elizabeth, this letter is needed before August 1st
  - These meeting notes have been requested as evidence of CBAC's support of this plan for the City Council meeting on August 16<sup>th</sup>.
- CBAC Vote on supporting this West Elizabeth Enhanced Travel Corridor Plan:
  - 10 yes votes out of 10 CBAC members to write a letter of support of the CDOT grant
  - 10 yes votes out of 10 CBAC members to allow these meeting notes to be used as our show of support to the City Council to adopt this plan
