1. Construction Updates (Aaron F)
  - a. Shields/Elizabeth Underpass
    - i. 2 week delay
    - ii. August 12 opening date
  - b. Lake
    - i. East Dr. closed, will be concrete with sharrows
    - ii. New transit stop
    - iii. South side has full sidewalk
  - c. Pitkin west side fully resurfaced and striped
    - i. Will add left turn pocket to cross Shields to Springfield
