Engineering: Construction Updates (David Hansen)

- Meridian to open next Monday
- Pitkin low-stress network, finishing up
- ADA ramps being installed
- Biology and Chemistry buildings should be finished later in summer
- HMC to open in next month
- City closing Lake St late July for 2 new phases of paving
- Pitkin repaving from RR tracks to East Dr
- Shields underpass coming along to open late August
- East Dr will be closed through most of the summer
- Wayfinding signage will start to be installed in the summer, bike/ped (~14 posts total)

The Spoke (Heather)

- 1700 visitors this past school year (up 32% increase), 38% increase in sales \$
- 65% of people are return visitors
- Tube changes, tire inflation, front/rear brake adjustments, derailleur
- 76% already have bike registered, more are registering when they're there (6%)
- 50% Freshmen.... (Heather fill in)
- 60-40 ratio of on vs off campus
- Walk by and friend are top reasons for visiting
- Promotion ideas:
  - Use sandwich boards at beginning of semester along bike trails

Covered bike parking update (David Hansen)

- Design concepts for covered bike parking (no walls), for large library rack bank “bike pavilion”
- Metal roof
- Supported by columns, align with racks
- Options with pitched roof vs overlapping angled roof
- Group likes first (angled) design best, most applicable to other sites on campus
- Consider: lighting, stormwater, snow removal
- Additional design concepts for combo of secure bike parking, repair area, etc.
- David to meet with architect tomorrow-, report CBAC feedback, will fine-tune designs, then send around to CBAC

Stadium/Athletics (AF)

- Athletics has stated publicly that they will have 2 bike valets
- Have committed to one valet so far; trailer for bags, helmets, etc.
- Will be designated stations for pedicabs
- Connected with Bike FC for feeder rides
- Athletics suggested having a Bike Day- special packages
- Will one of the Chairs ask Athletics to come to CBAC and explain?

Update from Bret: Homecoming 5k will be moved out to Hughes Stadium, want to provide incentive to have people ride their bike
