- City's bike and ped counts coming up in September
- Bike from Work parties at Intersect and Odell went well
- Transportation Equity subcommittee as part of City Plan
- Pace bike share has been running for about a month
- Learn to Ride class for international women at University Village

ENGINEERING

Construction Updates (Aaron F)

- Had to move a sprinkler mainline for construction of split trail in front of Moby, but about 90% finished
- Shepardson is really close to remodel. Currently in project plan
- Newsom/Aylesworth will become Meridian Village (student housing), will incorporate some creative surface parking increases (but not a new structure); Creative Services will move into Hartshorn

Bike to Work Day Results (Aaron B)

- 960 participants - highest ever for CSU station

- 3rd place -1,090 at Spring Creek/Mason Trail
- Discussion about how to expand participation from other campus partners (Alumni, External Relations, etc.)

 - Can't achieve platinum while College Ave doesn't allow bikes
 - New development along College may allow for development of bikeable sidewalk
 - Heather: The Spoke still closed due to flood
 - Bike and trailer for Mobile Spoke now at Central Receiving, being built, will be ready for move-in
 - Hired female paid intern to learn to be mechanic
 - Oct 12: NoCo leaders ride, Loveland to Fort Collins
 - Bret: Homecoming 5k now on a Sunday Oct 14 so it can be on campus
